



#### Most popular countries of origin of international students






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
### International students at Tecnológico de Monterrey

A fundamental part of our internationalization is experienced through our campuses thanks to the presence of students and faculty from around the world. During 2015, our multicultural environment, which brings the global vision of the Tecnológico de Monterrey's community to life, included 4,718 students from 71 countries and 589 international lecturers who enrolled in and gave classes, respectively, at one of our institution's 31 campuses.





"QS World University Rankings" ranks the Tecnológico de Monterrey #238 in the world and #9 among universities in Latin America.

> In 2015, 469 lecturers from the Tecnológico de Monterrey took part in international projects.
