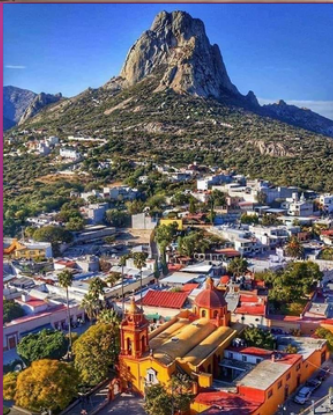
TEMPERATURE
